<p>Universal Waste:</p> <p>Rechargeable batteries (Lithium-ion, NiCd, NiMH, Nickel Zinc, Sealed Source Lead Acid) and cellphones</p>	<p>Less than 11 lbs</p> 	<p>Use Call2Recycle boxes available in 1C-201 Office of Student Life, or 1L lobby by turnstiles.</p> 	<p>Contact EHS at x4300 when the box is full</p>
<p>Universal Waste:</p> <p>Rechargeable batteries (Lead acid (Pb))</p>	<p>More than 11 lbs</p> 	<p>Via Buildings and Grounds– Laborers shop who collect them in a central location for pick-up by Universal Waste vendor</p>	<p>Contact B&G - Laborers shop at x3210, x3254</p>
<p>Non-hazardous Waste:</p> <p>Oil and debris</p>	<p>Motor oil, pump oil, oil filter, oily rags, oil contaminated items</p> 	<p>Via Buildings and Grounds – Laborers shop who collect it in a central location for pick-up by used oil vendor</p>	<p>Contact B&G - Laborers shop at x3210, 3254</p>

<p>Chemical reagents</p>	<p>Laboratory waste, unwanted photo chemicals, unwanted cleaning chemicals, chemically contaminated items, pesticides.</p> 	<p>Via EHS who store and stage chemicals for pick up by hazardous waste vendor</p>	<p>Contact EHS at x4300</p>
<p>Regulated medical waste</p>	<p>Free flowing blood and other bodily fluids, needles and sharps contaminated with blood and or other bodily fluids</p> 	<p>Via EHS who store and stage regulated medical waste for pick up by RMW vendor</p>	<p>Contact EHS at x4300</p>
<p>Printer supplies</p>	<p>Toner cartridges</p> 	<p>Via Operational Services who collect toner cartridges in a central location for shipment to vendor</p>	<p>Contact Operational Services at x3228</p>
<p>Fire extinguishers</p>	<p>Expired and discharged fire extinguishers</p> 	<p>Via Public Safety who collect fire extinguishers in central location for replacement by vendor</p>	<p>Contact Public Safety at x2111</p>
