 $\rightarrow$ Create lesson plans and unit plans

- Connect literature (research and theory) to practice in multiple ways
- Observe classrooms/teaching/students with an intentional lens

 $\rightarrow$ Low-inference, descriptive observation

- Give and receive meaningful feedback; act on feedback
- Collaborate with peers and colleagues to build professional community
- Critically reflect on myself as learner, teacher, and professional
