CUNY Research Scholars Program at the College of Staten Island

2026 – 2027 Academic Year

The CUNY Research Scholars Program (CRSP) is a unique opportunity that provides funded research experiences exclusively for associate degree students over one academic year. The program's primary goal is to enhance the involvement of high achieving undergraduate students in authentic research across various disciplines.

CRSP participants must be full-time associate degree students and commit to participating in the program for one full academic year plus the summer. To maintain eligibility, participants must engage in research projects in Chemistry, Biology, Neuroscience, Engineering, Math, Computer Science, Psychology, Linguistics, or similar.

Students receive up to a \$5,000 stipend for their participation in the program and present their findings at the CSI Undergraduate Conference and CUNY-wide CRSP Symposium.
