

CUNY Jabber Install Guide for Android Mobile

Jabber is a softphone which extends your CUNY office phone number to a compatible device.

Requirements:

A participating hardware platform. This guide is for Android systems.

Participating sites: Any CUNY site served by the Central Office Cisco Phone system.

A "login.cuny.edu" credential.

- 1) Contact your local Service Desk to request an Android Jabber account. Please specify if this is for a phone or tablet.
- 2) It is recommended that your Android device is registered to a wireless network.
- 3) Using your Android, visit the Play Store to Search for and Install "Cisco Jabber". Don't open the app yet.
- 4) Open this html document on your Android Device (usually the Chrome browser)
- 5) Click the following hyperlink to [Update Domain Settings](#). Jabber will launch.
- 6) Swipe left several times to read a brief tutorial. Press "Get Started" and answer some questions:
- 7) Importing Contacts is optional. **Record audio – Allow. Make and manage phone calls – Allow.** Access photos media and files (storage) – optional. **Battery usage – "Allow" is required to receive calls.**
- 8) Login to your CUNY Jabber account using Firstname.LastnameXX@login.cuny.edu
- 9) You will be prompted whether to use Biometric Authentication – optional.
- 10) Press the Calls icon and make a test call. On your first call you will be asked to allow/deny the camera.
