** Students should consult with their academic and financial aid advisor to confirm if such election will still allow them to count the course towards their major/degree requirements, if credit is earned with a grade of P. In order to receive this grade, a student needs to continue participating in academically related activities, complete all assignments, and take the final exam/culminating experience. If a passing letter grade is earned, the student will receive a grade of 'P' and credit for the course with no impact on GPA. If a failing grade is earned (F), the student has the option to receive a grade of NC/NP which does not affect the GPA. Students must remain in compliance with Federal and State Satisfactory Academic Progress guidelines

For Students who received an **INC grade in the Fall 2019 semester**, the University will allow students to submit incomplete work to faculty for resolution **through end of Summer 2020 semester**. The new deadline for faculty to submit Incomplete to Grade forms to the Registrar's Office for resolution will be **August 30, 2020**.
