If you are planning to request a letter of recommendation from the Pre-health Advisory Committee this semester, your portfolio must be complete. An incomplete portfolio may delay an appointment for the required interview with the committee. The committee would like to draft a letter for you in a timely manner. It will take at least **TWO** weeks to process your letter.

## PROCEDURAL CHECK LIST FOR PRE-MED COMMITTEE LETTER

## **Eligibility**

- Enroll in College of Staten Island for minimum of two semesters
- Complete at least 12 credits of listed pre-required classes Biology; Chemistry and Physics at CSI and minimum of 30 credits at CSI
- Minimum of 3.00 cumulative grade point average adjusted to include any "F" grades
- Minimum of 3.00 science GPA of classes completed at CSI
- Completion of minimum of 150 hours of volunteer shadowing in health care provider or paid direct patient care experience
- Completion of minimum of 100 hours of community service
- Participated in research for at least two semesters prior pre-medical candidates only and one semester for pre-dental candidates
- Submission of all required letters of recommendations and letters of volunteering prior to interview
- Complete MCAT/DAT/OAT and submit score
- Attend Pre-health information session. Information sessions provide overview of the Pre-Health requirements and extracurricular activities such as community service and research
- Proof of Pre-professional club participation for minimum of 10 club meetings
- Pre health file will be kept for 2 years after opening and will be discarded after
- All candidates who are reapplying will require re-interview if the committee letter needs to be updates with additional curricular and extracurricular activities. No re-interview will be required for reapplicants if only test core needs to be updated.
- Meet with pre-health advisor prior to opening pre-health file.

Notified the Office of the Dean of Science and Technology to request an interview appointment (1A-313 x2430) <b>no later than the beginning</b> of classes the semester you are requesting to be interviewed - for fall and winter semester this will be September 1 <sup>st</sup> and spring and summer will be February 1 <sup>st</sup> . Please state if you have a <b>deadline date</b> for your application and letter of recommendation
If you attended CSI, you don't have to submit an official transcript. If you attended another school, please have the <b>official</b> transcripts
Attached MCAT/DAT/ other scores that directly impact on admission criteria. The Pre-Health committee will not interview you until they have the MCAT/DAT/ OAT scores
Enclosed (3) letters of recommendation reflecting on the academic performance of the candidate: at least 2 from CSI science faculty (at least one letter has to be from full time faculty). The faculty can email the letters of recommendation to <a href="mailto:Debbie.Britton@csi.cuny.edu">Debbie.Britton@csi.cuny.edu</a> . Please <b>note</b> reference letters submitted after the interview has been scheduled will not be considered
Enclosed a recommendation letter from a health care provider practicing in the field the candidate plans to enter
Attend Pre-Health Advisement information session
Enclosed reference letter from your research mentor. The letter must describe in detail the research you conducted.
Enclosed letter of 150 hour of shadowing pre-health provider in the in the filed the candidates plans to enter
Enclosed letter of 100 hour of community service
Enclosed transcript of 10 club meetings
Enclosed a letter verifying you met at least once prior to requesting interview with pre-med committee member for advisement

Enclosed updated CV
