- 1. Matriculation at the College of Staten Island;
- 2. Passage of CUNY Mathematics and English Assessment Test;
- 3. Completion of a minimum of 40 credits, including SWK 200 or its equivalent or above;
- 4. Completion of MTH 113 Introduction to Probability and Statistics;
- 5. Pertinent volunteer experience or previous work history will be considered in evaluation of your application;
- 6. Completion of a well-written, thoughtful personal stated, as outlined in later in the application;
- 7. An Interview may be required.

Admission Procedures

- 1. Submission of a complete, accurate, and on time application. Incomplete applications will delay the admission process.
- 2. After applying you will receive confirmation of receipt of application. If you have not heard from us within two weeks of submission, please contact the Department of Social Work.
- 3. The Department of Social Work will communicate the department's decision by email.
- You are expected to respond to the application decision offer within two weeks from acceptance. You will be provided with a form indicating your decision to accept or decline the offer.
