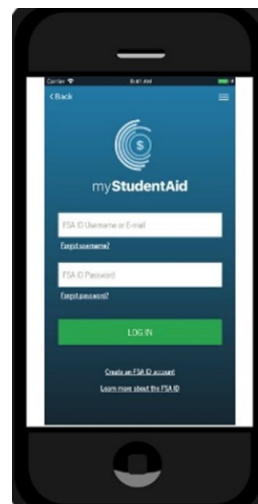

Get Your FSA ID

- Both you and a parent need Federal Student Aid Identification Numbers (FSA IDs) to complete and electronically sign your FAFSA and other federal student aid documents.
- Visit <https://fsaid.ed.gov> to get your FSA ID.

Gather these Materials

For both student/spouse and parent(s), if dependent:

- **2017** Income tax returns, if tax filers
- **2017** W-2 forms and other records of money earned
- **Current** bank statements and investment records
- **2017** Records of other untaxed income, such as child support received, IRA/pension deductions, veteran's benefits, or military allowances

Complete the FAFSA at www.fafsa.gov

Be sure to use the **IRS Data Retrieval Tool** (if eligible)

- Instantly transfer information from the IRS with the click of a button
- Accurately fill in tax data fields
- Will not need to provide tax documents to the Financial Aid Office for verification

Verification

- The US Department of Education randomly selects a certain number of applications for Verification. Comply promptly with all requests for additional information or documentation by the Office of Student Financial Aid. If you fail to comply with any such request, the processing of your application will be suspended.
- If you are selected for Verification and did not use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool, you will need to request student/spouse and/or your parents 2017 IRS Tax Return Transcript at <https://www.irs.gov/transcript> or a non-filing letter (4506-T), if you are independent and did not file.
