

Applying for the New York State High School Equivalency Diploma Based on Earned College Credit

Application packet for CSI students needing to satisfy TAP Ability to Benefit Requirements because they graduated from a foreign high school.

General Information

Students who have earned at least 24 college credits toward a degree can apply for the NYS High School Equivalency Diploma Based on Earned College Credit. The 24 credits must include at least:

- 6 credits in English
- 3 credits in mathematics
- 3 credits in the natural sciences (Biology, Chemistry, Environmental Science, Geology, Physics & Astronomy)
- 3 credits in social science (Anthropology, Economics, Geography, Linguistics, Political Science and Global Affairs, Psychology, Sociology)
- 3 credits in the humanities (History, Media Culture, Performing and Creative Arts, Philosophy, World Languages and Literatures)

A non-refundable fee of \$10 must be submitted with the application. Payment must be in the form of certified check or money order. DO NOT send cash or a personal check.

To Apply:

- 1. Complete the Application For The New York State High School Equivalency Diploma Based On Earned College Credit.
- 2. Complete *the student's information* on the College Credit Certification Form (do NOT write in the space reserved for the Registrar's information).
- 3. Obtain a \$10 certified check or money order payable NY State Department of Education
- 4. Take the Application, the Credit Verification Form and the \$10 certified check or money order to the CSI Registrar's Office, building 2A room 107.

After the Registrar's Office completes and seals the bottom section of the Credit Certification Form, you must mail the Application, the Credit Certification Form and the \$10 certified check and money order to:

Guidelines:

Registrar's Signature

An eligible person may be awarded a New York State High School Equivalency Diploma if he or she provides satisfactory evidence that he or she has successfully completed 24 credits as a recognized candidate for a degree or certificate at an approved institution. Some institutions require a person to have a high school diploma in order to be recognized as a candidate for a degree. If the lack of a diploma or its equivalent is the only impediment to a person being **recognized** as a candidate for an approved degree or certificate program, the individual may be considered as a recognized candidate for a degree or certificate for the purpose of completing this form.

Credits for courses taken solely for personal and/or cultural advancement, and not required as part of an approved degree or certificate program, may **not** be used to obtain an equivalency diploma. For example, a student who successfully completes non-degree courses representing 24 or more credits is not eligible for an equivalency diploma.

If you meet the requirements for a High School Equivalency Diploma based on college credit and have completed

and mailed the attached application with the required fee, then complete this section of the College Credit Certification Form and request the registrar of the institution to certify that you have met the college credit requirements for an equivalency diploma. The registrar should complete the bottom section of this form, attach a transcript, and return it to the above address.
