The School of Education and Social Work at the College of Staten Island (CSI), CUNY, seeks an adjunct assistant professor to teach a course in Psychological Foundations-Learning and Development for the Fall 2026 (08/26/2026 - 12/22/2026) and beyond. The course examines the developing child from the end of preschool until the emergence of adolescence, focusing on grades K to 6. Theories of development and the interaction of cognitive and social-emotional aspects of learning and development are emphasized. Children with differing abilities are discussed, including neurodiversity, as well as cultural, gender, and socioeconomic factors. Students are expected to complete fifteen (15) hours of fieldwork in varied educational settings to increase understanding of classroom learning.
